

Could All the Events of The Events of the Sixth Day of Creation Occur Between Morning and Evening of a Twenty-Four Hour Day?

The List of Events that Occurred Between Morning and Evening on the Sixth Day of Creation:

- 1 Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth living creatures after their kind...." (Gen 1:24)
- 2 God made the beasts of the earth.... (Gen 1:25a)
- 3 God saw that it was good. (Gen 1:25b)
- 4 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image...." (Gen 1:26)
- 5 Then the LORD God formed man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being.(Gen 2:7)
- 6 The LORD God planted a garden toward the east, in Eden... Out of the ground the LORD God caused to grow every tree that is pleasing to the sight and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. (Gen 2:8-9)
- 7 Now a river flowed out of Eden to water the garden; and from there it divided and became four rivers. (Gen 2:10)
- 8 Then the LORD God took the man and put him into the garden of Eden to cultivate it and keep it. (Gen 2:15)
- 9 The LORD God commanded the man, saying, "From any tree of the garden you may eat freely; but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat from it you will surely die." (Gen 2:16-17)
- 10 Then the LORD God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone; I will make him a helper suitable for him." (Gen 2:18)
- 11 ...The LORD God ... brought them [every beast of the field and every bird of the sky] to the man to see what he would call them;.... (Gen 2:19)
- 12 The man gave names to all the cattle, and to the birds of the sky, and to every beast of the field.... (Gen 2:20)
- 13 ...the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon the man, and he slept; then He took one of his ribs and closed up the flesh at that place. (Gen 2:21)
- 14 The LORD God fashioned into a woman the rib which He had taken from the man, (Gen 2:22a)
- 15 And brought her to the man. (Gen 2:22b)
- 16 The man said, "This is now bone of my bones, And flesh of my flesh; she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man."(Gen 2:23)
- 17 God blessed them; and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it; and rule...." (Gen 1:28)
- 18 Then God said, "Behold, I have given you every plant... on the surface of all the earth... it shall be food for you;" (Gen 1:29)
- 19 God saw all that He had made, and behold, it was very good. And there was evening and there was morning, the sixth day. (Gen 1:30)

It is hard to believe that the reader is expected to understand all these events took place between the morning and evening of one twenty-four day - especially the naming all the animals and birds.
